Visit to The National Holocaust Museum
Tuesday 5th November 2019

We have arranged a trip for the Year 6 classes to visit The National Holocaust Museum in Nottinghamshire. During the trip, we will be spending half a day in the exhibition and the other half listening to the testimony of a Holocaust survivor. During the exhibition, we will be learning about the life of a 10-year-old German Jewish boy living in Berlin during the war. This trip will launch our new topic 'A Child's War' where children will look in depth at when and why World War Two started, the impact it had on countries and the devastation it caused to different religious groups.

The trip has been booked for Tuesday 5th November and we are asking you to make a contribution of £15.00 per child. **If your child is eligible for Pupil Premium, a discount has been applied and will be visible on your ParentPay payment item for this trip.** Please make payment online via ParentPay by **Tuesday 29th October 2019.**

Should insufficient payments be received the trip may be cancelled.

Children should arrive at school at 8:45am at the latest as we will be leaving school at 9:00am and children will arrive back at school to be collected at 3.15-3.30pm. Updates on arrival times will be sent via email/Twitter should we be delayed. **Please provide a packed lunch on the day for your child (no glass bottles please). If your child is entitled to a free school meal, then please let the office know in advance and a packed lunch can be provided for your child.** Please provide a drink in a suitable container, even if you require a school packed lunch. The children must wear school uniform; the trip will go ahead whatever the weather and will be predominantly inside but please ensure that your child wears suitable clothes, shoes and coats.
