Collection arrangements



The safety of our Redlands children is one of our highest priorities, which we take very seriously. When it is necessary to make other arrangements for someone to collect your child from school, the following steps will help us to keep your child safe:

- If you have a regular arrangement for someone other than yourself to collect your child from school, e.g. a grandparent, childminder, family friend, their names and details can be added to the contacts for your child. Please contact the office to discuss.
- If you need to make a one-off or occasional alternative arrangement for someone to collect your child, you can let the class teacher know in the morning, or write it in their homework diary, or if you do not know until later in the day, please contact the school office **in advance or on the day, before 2pm**, so that we can make the class teacher aware.
- If it is not likely that the teacher will recognise the person collecting, please also give a password to the office and the person collecting, so that we can ensure that the correct person is collecting your child.
- If making arrangements on the day, please call and speak to the office rather than emailing or leaving a voicemail, as these can easily be missed during busy periods.

Polite reminders

School opens | The school gates open at 8:40am. Children are the responsibility of the parent until 8:45am and must be supervised on the playground.

Contacting a teacher | If you wish to talk to a class teacher during the school day then please call and make an appointment.
